Class Supply List



Traditionally sewn by hand, this vintage block can be created entirely by machine, too. Using quick rotary cut kite shapes, you will learn how easy it is to sew three together using a simple (and doable) y-seam. Twenty-four units are then stitched into the Rose Star Block with ONLY straight seams. The coloring chart (next page) helps you plan your fabrics before you finalize them.... and you can make it in a variety of sizes. Make one, and it's a large table topper. Make several and you have the beginnings of an amazing full-sized quilt. Debby will discuss how to "square up" the blocks to work them into a larger quilt, and discuss adding borders to the hexagon shape (to make it larger).

Finished size of 'one' is 30" x 34".



Rose Star pattern and kit includes:

- Well illustrated, multi-page pattern.
- Laser cut acrylic template for cutting our kite shapes
- Sample fabrics to make one 3-kite block (various fabrics)
- Tip sheet for using the kite shape in other blocks and quilt assemblies

Kit fee: \$17

It is helpful to also bring: blue painter's tape, straight pins (thin) and a friction marking pen.

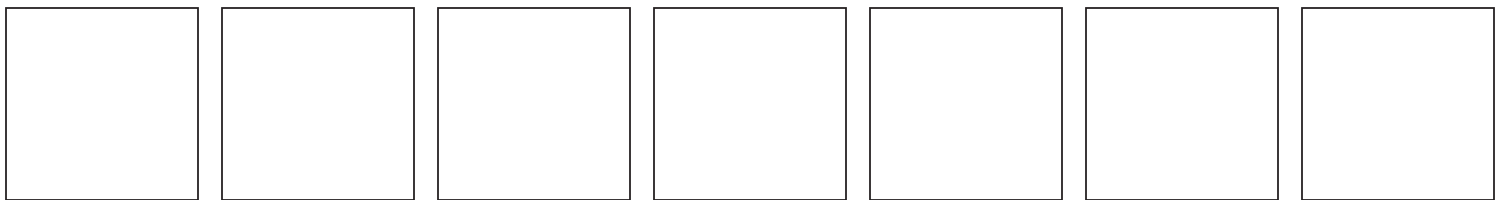
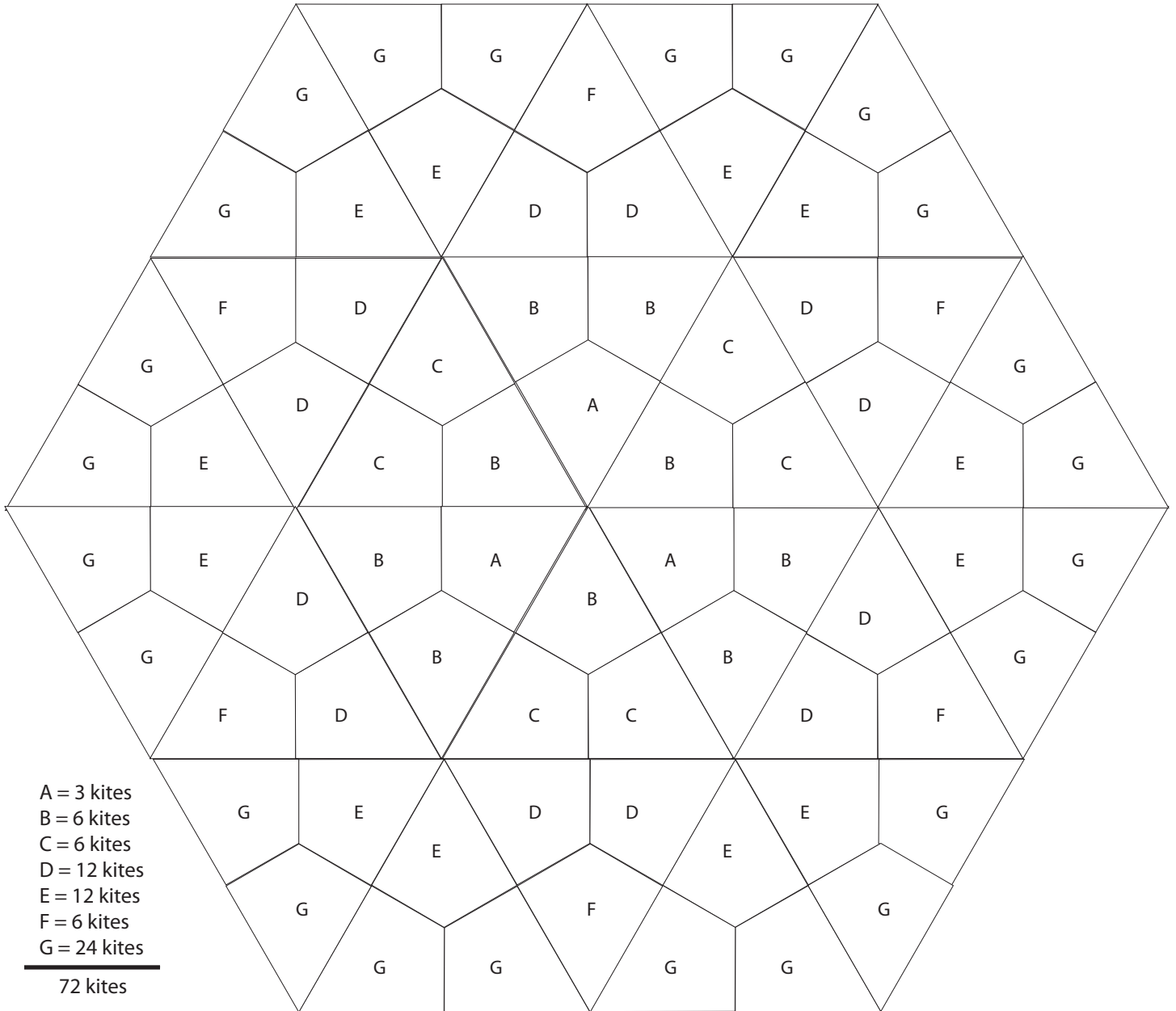
My example uses 7 different fabrics. Use the next page to plan your own quilt. All patches are cut from strips cut 4-1/4" x WOF (width of fabric). Each 40" strip yields 11 fabric kites.

- Fabric A: One strip 4-1/4" x 22" (for 3 kites). Recut into two 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric B: One strip 4-1/4" x 42/44" (for 9 kites). Recut into five 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric C: One strip 4-1/4" x wof (for 6 kites). Recut into five 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric D: Two strips 4-1/4" x wof (for 12 kites). Recut ONE strip into five 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric E: Two strips 4-1/4" x wof (for 12 kites). Recut ONE strip into five 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric F: One strip 4-1/4" x wof (for 6 kites). Recut into five 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric G: Three strips 4-1/4" x wof (for 24 kites). Recut ONE strip into five 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles

(The recutting of the strips into 7-1/2" wedges will speed up our template cutting in class) Bring extra fabrics. The Rose Star Block uses a total of 72 kites. The next page helps you plan your design.

We will discuss finishing our topper with binding or even squaring it up in class. No yardages are given at this time for these.
