

Mini-Quilt Auction Fundraiser



Entry Requirements

- A separate Entry Form must be completed for each item entered.
- Entrant must choose the guild that is receiving the donation. 100% of the money collected for each quilt will go to the guild designated by the donator.
- Mini Quilts must be no larger than 24" on any side and no smaller than 10".
- Mini Quilts may not be made with a licensed fabric (for example: Disney, Sport's Teams, or College Logos).
- Textile Art, Bags, and other items must be able to be displayed in 24" x 24" space and be able to be hung on a rod.
- Every entry requires a unique, non-generic name for tracking purposes. Using "Mini Quilt 1" is not sufficient. (If you are at a loss, use your initials + some identifying feature of the quilt, for example, JJ Red Duck)
- All entries must be 'Show Quality,' clean, in good condition, and free of animal hair and smoke smell.
- Entries will be accepted in the order registered, with the total number of entries limited per site and participating guild.
- The Auction Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry it deems inappropriate or does not meet the requirements.
- All entries must be submitted online using the form below by 11:59 PM June 15, 2026.
- 100% of the money collected for each quilt will go to the guild designated by the donator.
- Quilts entered in the 2026 NTQF Quilt Contest may not be sold in the 2026 Mini Auction.

Quilt Preparation

- All entries must be able to be hung on a 2" rod.
- Mini Quilts must have a 2" sleeve attached (start with a strip at least 4.5 inches wide). The sleeve should include ½" of ease and be stitched to the quilt on both the top and bottom of the sleeve. Entries without a correctly sized sewn sleeve will not be accepted.
- Entries must have a label with the following: Maker's name, Guild name. and credit to the pattern maker if a copyright pattern is used.

Quilt Submission

- After submitting this form, print out the auto-generated email you receive, and attach a copy to your entry.
- Your Auction items must be turned in to your guild representative by June 30, 2026.
- If assistance is needed, or you have questions about where to take your entry, please contact your guild Mini Auction and/or NTQF representative.
