Easy enough for beginners!
Large, 18" block size.

Fabric Requirements for Single Block Quilt:

- Two 2-1/2" x wof strips of Color A; recut into 8 strips 2-1/2" x 9-1/2"
- Two 2-1/2" x wof strips of Color B; recut into 8 strips 2-1/2" x 9-1/2"
- One 5-1/2" x wof strip of Color A; recut into 8 strips 3-3/4" x 5-1/2"
- One 5-1/2" x wof strip of Color B; recut into 8 strips 3-3/4" x 5-1/2"
- One 9-1/2" x wof strip for curved BG fabric (Fabric C)
- Two 3" squares EACH of TWO colors for the center block triangles

-- Add-a-Quarter ruler strongly advised

Borders: We will discuss in class. Fat quarters will work well.

Fabric Requirements for Multiple Blocks:

Note the yardages above and calculate what you need for 2, 3 or even 4 blocks. In our 3 hour class, we will concentrate on piecing the blocks. We will discuss finishing techniques.

The 3 Block Runner additional yardage:

- Three 9-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles.

A traditional Lone Star can be both paper pieced AND set into curved background units! The beauty of using just two colors for the star creates a positive-negative effect. Make one 18" block or several. We begin with pre-cut strips to make this go quickly and smoothly.
