

Festive Starfish Quilt© by Debby Kratovil



Block Size: 16" Quilt Size: 34" x 34"

Fabrics for ONE block with special setting (as shown above):

- Light BG fabric (1/4 yd): two 4-1/2" squares; eight 2-1/2" x 6" strips; eight 2-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips
- Color A (my gold): four 2-1/2" x 3-3/4" and four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.
- Color B (my red): two 2-1/2" x 6" strips and two 2-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips.
- Color C (my green): two 2-1/2" x 6" strips and two 2-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips.
- Print block background (black & white print): One 8-1/2" x wof strip OR a Fat quarter
- Two 10" squares for setting block on point (my red/gold/green print) OR Fat quarter
- Inner border (red and green strips): two 1-1/2" x wof strips of EACH color OR 2 Fat quarters
- Outer border: 1/3 yard
- Binding: 1/3 yard
- Add-a-Quarter ruler is a must!
- Two 8-1/2" squares freezer paper

Four block quilt : 44" x 44"

- 1-1/4 yard white background
- 1/3 yard gold for blocks
- 1/3 yard red for blocks & inner border
- 1/3 yard blue for blocks
- 1/2 yard blue print for curved backgrounds
(I suggest 3/4 yard to be safe).
- 3/4 yard outer border
- 1/3 yard binding
- Two 8-1/2" squares freezer paper

Begin with the cuts as for the red quilt;
bring your fabric and cut the rest as you go.

Choose 3 bright colors and foundation piece a variation of an off-center log cabin block with curved edges. Set the four units into the curved print background and then place it onpoint with pieced setting triangles (it just looks hard!) Who says your inner borders have to be the same color?

The option of making four big blocks will also be discussed, with directions for putting them all together. Pattern includes masters and 4 newsprint foundations.

Keep each of the strips/units pinned together.
We will identify them in class.
