
Seven Sisters Variation[©] Quilt by Debby Kratovil





Go for a scrappy version!

Seven Sisters is a vintage block that has been streamlined for easy piecing with NO y-seams. Based on a 60 degree diamond, the addition of colored strips at the edges of the block create an extra design element. With just 6 large blocks (16" x 18") and setting triangles, this 51" x 61" quilt is a perfect lap size!

Materials & Pre-cutting:

- 1-1/4 yard single background print (my cream & gold)
- \bullet Recut into 5 strips 3-1/2" x wof. These are for the small triangles in the stars.
- \bullet Recut into 3 strips 8-1/2" x wof for large setting triangles ½ yard Color A for star points
- Recut into three 3-1/2" x wof strips (each strip = 6 diamonds) ½ yard Color B for star points
- Recut into three 3-1/2" x wof strips (each strip = 6 diamonds) ½ yard Color C for strips surrounding stars
- Recut into five 2-1/2" x wof strips (each strip = four units) ½ yard Color D for strips surrounding stars
- Recut into five 2-1/2" x wof strips (each strip = four units) 1/3 yard inner border (my green)

1 yard+ for 6" outer border (we address this in class; do NOT precut) ½ yard for binding

Kit contains well illustrated pattern and multi-sized 60 degree triangle ruler with blunted tip. If you bring your own, I will refund the cost of the ruler.
