

## **MUST HAVE'S...**

#### 1. 6 different fabrics...

This is a double sided (optional) quilt pattern. You will use 6 different fabrics. It is suggested that you pick your fabrics to coordinate with a holiday or celebration (Thanksgiving, Fourth of July, Christmas, Kwanza, Hanukkah, etc.)

Fabric #6 will be your 'background' fabric.

Fabric #1 will be your 'focal' fabric in the center of the quilt. Using a large print with a fussy cut tends to work well.

### 2. If you are creating both sides...

You will not need backing material, but will need:

- a. 1 yard of Fabric #1
- b. 2 yards of Fabric #2
- c. 1 yard Fabric #3
- d. ½ yard- Fabric #4
- e. ¾ yard- Fabric #5
- f. 4 ½ yards- Fabric #6

### 3. If you plan to use a plain backing...

You will need the following material:

- a. ½ yard of Fabric #1
- b. 1/6 yard of Fabric #2

- c. 1/3 yard Fabric #3
- d. 1/6 yard- Fabric #4
- e. 2/3 yard- Fabric #5
- f. 2 1/4 yards- Fabric #6

# 4. To be ready for class, you will need to cut...

Fabric #1: 3 strips -5 %" x WOF (cut one square of 5 %" x 5 %" from one of the strips)

Fabric #2: 1 strip- 5 %" x WOF (cut one square of 5 %" x 5 %" from one of the strips)

Fabric #3: 2 strips- 5 ½" x WOF

Fabric #4: 1 strip- 5 ½" x WOF

Fabric #5: 4 strips – 5 ½" x WOF

Fabric #6: 6 strips- 5 ½" x WOF

9 strips- 3" x WOF

## 5. Favorite Tools (including your glasses)...

Bring your normal quilting supplies (needles, pins, thread to match your fabric, etc). If you have numbered pins or post it notes, they are helpful to keep your fabric organized.
