

## Fourth of July on Ellis Island

### Materials List

Rotary cutters with new blades (I use two rotary cutters, 45mm and 28 mm for small arc)  
12"x12" 360° rotating mat (if you do not have one, you may want to get one)  
Clear Scotch tape  
Stiletto or Curved Long Tweezers (I will have some for sale)  
Patchwork pins – fine by clover (item #2507CV) (I will have some for sale)  
Small sharp scissors and paper scissors or an old blade for your rotary cutter  
Paper and pencil  
Thread to match your fabrics  
Reading/sewing glasses (if you use them)  
Anything else you can't sew without

### The Fabric

This project is scrap, fat quarter, and yardage friendly. WOF is assumed at 42"

FOR BIG SECTIONS OF BLOCKS, you need 36 squares 10" x 10" (I used 6 different fabrics on 4<sup>th</sup> of July)

FOR EACH PAPER PIECED ARCS (bring enough to make at least four)

1 piece 3 ¼" x 21" (background)

1 piece 3 ¼" x 8" (rays 1)

1 piece 3 ¼" x 8" (rays 2)

Bring any extra fabric you may want to use in this project, be it yardage, fat quarters or scraps.
